LABEL STORY: *Amor Fati translates in Latin to “the love of one’s fate.”*

Aggressive and engulfing, yet showcasing restrained balance on the palate; tannins are lush, round, unprecedented. Labels are sketch renditions of William Blake’s 1793 work “The Marriage Of Heaven and Hell.” Look deep into the symmetrical label to find Whimsical scene of women, mermaids and babies dancing with the serpent around the tree of life. Drink more to see more.

VINEYARD: *Murmur Vineyard*

South facing sand slope, weathers 25° diurnal shifts, summer sun and bitter winds. Borders the most South Western portion of Santa Maria AVA, 12 miles from the Pacific Ocean. Dynamic varieties, clones, rootstock and innovative farming.

WINEMAKER’S TASTING NOTES:

Striking notes of blackberry, black plum, lavender and a hint of sweet spice and black pepper. Juicy acidity and good tension on the palate with flavors of ripe black and blue berries, accompanied by the classic cool climate Syrah notes of black olive and fresh ground pepper. Integrated acidity and tannins play out nicely on the finish.
